SEXUAL ASSAULT CRISIS PROGRAMS REPORT

The Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention (GOCCP) is a part of the Executive Branch of State Government. GOCCP's mission is to serve as the State Administering Agency in the application for, and administration of, federal and state funds for public safety, crime control and prevention; and to coordinate and promote public safety linkages and partnerships between and among federal, state and local agencies. The office is Maryland's one stop shop for resources to improve public safety and exists to educate, connect, and empower Maryland's citizens and public safety entities through innovative funding, strategic planning, crime data analysis, best practices research and results-oriented customer service.

During the 2011 Legislative Session, the Maryland Department of Human Resources (DHR) proposed legislation to transfer the Domestic Violence and Rape Crisis/Sexual Assault Programs to GOCCP. This transfer became effective July 1, 2011 thru the passage of HB 739. The Sexual Assault Crisis Program is established by Criminal Procedure Article § 11-923(g) of the Annotated Code of Maryland.


The Maryland Rape Crisis Program is a statewide program funded through State general funds and Sexual Assault Prevention funds from the Centers for Disease Control. Services are provided through a network of community-based rape crisis programs and are available in every jurisdiction in Maryland. These programs provide comprehensive services to meet the specific needs of rape and sexual offenses and family members affected by the abuse. Having these services available on a local level increases the likelihood that victims will avail themselves of the services and that there shall be appropriate linkages to other community-based services as needed. Additionally, provision of services and community education fosters a coordinated community approach to serving victims of rape and sexual assault that includes partnerships with law enforcement, courts, hospitals, local departments of social services and other related support agencies.

These funds are used to provide services to adult and child victims of rape and other sexual offenses. Services to victims include a 24-hour hotline, counseling, medical accompaniment, and assistance in accessing and using other support services such as legal assistance. Additionally, funds are designated for specific prevention efforts throughout the State. These efforts include presentations to community groups, pamphlets, and radio & television public service announcements. Currently, funds support 17 rape crisis programs that serve all 24 jurisdictions in Maryland. These programs consist of both private and non-profit agencies as well as governmental agencies.


The O'Malley-Brown Administration set a strategic policy goal to reduce Violent Crimes Committed Against Women and Children by 25% by the end of 2012. In 2012, there were 1,235 forcible rapes reported. This represents a 3.3% increase when compared to 2011 and remains higher than 5 years ago. In this light, it is critical to address these issues and reduce rapes in all jurisdictions throughout the State.

The Administration is setting a new strategic goal: Reduce violent crimes committed against women and children by an additional 25% by the end of 2018.

Prior to January 2012, the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program defined forcible rape as the carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will. Attempts or assaults to commit rape by force or threat of force were also included; however, statutory rape (without force) and other sex offenses were excluded. The FBI changed the UCR

definition in January 2012 to include the rape of men and crimes that involve oral or anal penetration or penetration with objects.

The 2010 National Intimate Partner and Sexual Violence Survey (NISVS) defined rape as any completed or attempted unwanted vaginal (for women), oral, or anal penetration through the use of physical force (such as being pinned or held down, or by the use of violence) or threats to physically harm and includes times when the victim was drunk, high, drugged, or passed out and unable to consent. The definition of “sexual violence other than rape” included being made to penetrate someone else, sexual coercion, unwanted sexual contact, and non-contact unwanted sexual experiences. The data in this section reflects those definitions.

- Maryland women have the 3rd highest lifetime prevalence of sexual violence other than rape, totaling an estimated number of 1,248,000 women, about 54.9% of the female population in the State. *CDC, NISVS, 2011*
- Maryland women have the 6th highest lifetime prevalence of rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner in the country, totaling an estimated number of 957,000 women, about 42% of the female population in the State. *CDC, NISVS, 2011*
- An estimated number of 466,000 Maryland women have experienced rape in their lifetime, or 20.5% of the female population in the State. *CDC, NISVS, 2011*

Three commendable rape crisis intervention services’ programs include TurnAround, Inc.(Baltimore County), For All Seasons, Inc., and the Domestic Violence Sexual Assault Resource Center (Dove Center).

TurnAround is a domestic violence and sexual assault center in Baltimore, Maryland that helps women, children, and families who are victims of abuse. The center has served victims of rape and sexual assault/abuse for over 33 years. It is the only sexual assault provider in Baltimore City and County. There are several components of the program designed to address the unique needs of survivors of sexual violence. The program provides a continuum of care for adults and children who have been affected by rape, sexual assault, sexual abuse and/or sex trafficking. Victims have access to trauma therapy, emergency shelter, support of a victim advocate in the emergency room and after, and case management. In addition, the agency’s Community Education Department provides education about sexual assault and sex trafficking to adults, children, and professionals.

Since the start of this award period, sixty new individuals enrolled in individual therapy and worked on stabilization. Six individuals participated in group therapy that provides peer support. Victim Advocates provided crisis response and support through forensic exams to one hundred sexual assault victims in local emergency rooms. Community Educators reached 466 students and professionals through educational presentations. They renewed a relationship with Baltimore County Schools and are in the process of training 400 school counselors.

For All Seasons (FAS) has served as the Rape Crisis/Sexual Assault Center for five counties of Maryland's Mid-Shore since 1986. FAS provides a continuum of victim centered services

to underserved individuals residing in a rural setting, including a 24 hour Hotline and Emergency Response to local hospitals, crisis counseling, personal advocacy, case management, supportive therapy, and psychiatric interventions. Licensed as an outpatient mental health clinic in 2000, FAS has developed a clinical capacity to provide a wide range of trauma related services, as well as mental health regimens. FAS is the only Rape Crisis/Sexual Assault Center on the Mid-Shore as well as the only private, not for profit, outpatient mental health clinic with offices in each of the five counties. In addition to receiving direct referrals for victim services, FAS collaborates with Mid-Shore Council on Family Violence to provide mental health treatment for victims of DV and partners with the local Departments of Social Services to provide mental health treatment to child victims of physical/sexual abuse and neglect. FAS received over 15 Caliber Awards for program development and services from Mid-Shore Mental Health Systems, the local Core Service Agency and public mental health authority for the five counties of the Mid-Shore.

Since the start of this award period, 82 victims of sexual violence sought supportive services from FAS to include the agency's 24/7 hotline, emergency advocacy response to local hospitals, case management, trauma informed care through psychotherapy and psychiatric treatment. FAS responded to 40 hotline calls, provided crisis counseling to 7 individuals, responded to 7 individuals in local emergency departments, assisted 1 victim in court accompaniment and provided 77 victims with individual counseling and/or therapy.

The Domestic Violence Sexual Assault Resource Center, Inc. (Dove Center) is a private non-profit agency that provides safety, advocacy, support and counseling to individuals whose lives have been shattered by domestic violence and/or sexual assault, and strives to expand public awareness of those issues. This November, the agency reached its 21st anniversary of providing comprehensive services to victims of sexual and domestic violence and their families in Garrett County.

The Dove Center offers all services required to be considered a comprehensive program. A 24-hour hotline is operated from the agency's emergency shelter facility, and has been in operation since 1997. The hotline is staffed by crisis advocates, all of whom have extensive training and experience in responding to crisis calls. The agency also offers crisis intervention and supportive/educational counseling to adult and child victims, their families and friends. This is offered in both group and individual formats.

The Center works closely with the Garrett County Sexual Assault Team (SART), which includes Garrett Memorial Hospital, the State's Attorney for Garrett County, Garrett County Sheriff's Office, Garrett County Department of Social Services, as well as the Forensic Nurses of Cumberland Memorial Hospital to provide sexual assault forensic exams to victims in Garrett County. The Center works closely with other local agencies, to provide a coordinated community response to victims, and to assist victims with accessing helpful resources. Additionally, the Center assists victims with accessing other services through the Health Department and Department of Social Services, including: healthy families, personal health, family planning, substance abuse, entitlements, in-home family support services, and a variety of other programs. The agency has a close working relationship with the Garrett County Sheriff's Office, as well as the Maryland State Police. Child-care for clients is

offered through a referral process to programs including those offered by the local Community Action Committee and Department of Social Services. Health care is also offered through a referral process to local physicians.

Since the start of this award period, 14 new and 14 continuing clients received services. Six new clients received hotline services and 4 new clients received crisis intervention. Of the total new and ongoing, 27 hotline calls were handled, 21 individual counseling sessions, one legal accompaniment, 30 information and referrals, one assistance with other systems, and one transportation assistance. Five community education presentations took place, reaching 417 individuals.




Member Rape Crisis & Recovery Centers
