RE: FY 2007 First Quarterly Report on Deaths in Correctional Facilities

Dear Chairmen:

Your October 20, 2006, letter to the Secretary of Budget and Management indicated your agreement to allow the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to provide ongoing data on deaths occurring in correctional facilities on a quarterly basis. This letter contains data on deaths occurring during the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2007. For the Committees' convenience, the data is presented in the same format utilized in the Joint Chairmen's Report submitted on October 2, 2006.

During the months of July through September, there was a total of 21 deaths of individuals confined to correctional institutions. The largest number of those deaths falls into the "natural" or "illness related" category as a result of the lifestyles of these individuals. The table below provides a synopsis of these death events.
