Dear Governor Hogan, President Ferguson, and Speaker Jones:

The RELIEF Act established the Recovery Now Fund, authorizing the Comptroller’s Office to issue economic impact payments to certain Maryland residents. I am quite proud to say that the agency made that rollout happen seamlessly, and with very limited time to do so.

Thanks to the establishment of a uniquely collaborative emergency workgroup, 98 percent of Economic Impact Payments were processed within four days of the RELIEF Act becoming law on Monday, February 15, 2021. Additional payments were processed over the succeeding months as additional eligible taxpayers were identified. In accordance with Section 7(e) of the RELIEF Act, please note the final tally of payments for 2022 below.
