Based on our analysis, the Board submits a revised estimate of general fund revenues for fiscal year 2016 of \$16.404 billion and an estimate of \$17.022 billion for fiscal year 2017.

The Board and the Revenue Monitoring Committee will continue to meet and analyze revenue and economic trends in anticipation of December's estimates.
