Dear Senator Muse and Delegate Jones:

Section 14-305(a)(1) of the State Finance and Procurement Article requires each agency to provide the Joint Committee on Fair Practices and Personnel Oversight a copy of their annual Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) Report. Attached is a copy of the Department's FY 2015 Annual MBE Report.

During FY 2015, a total of \$21.9 million (2.43%) of DBM awards went to MBE prime contractors and subcontractors, an increase of almost \$21.3 million over FY 14 awards to MBE prime and subcontractors. DBM payments to MBE prime contractors and subcontractors exceeded \$7.6 million. An additional \$61.6 million in payments were made to MBE subcontractors which are not included in the above reported payment total due to pro-rating requirements.

Also noteworthy for FY 2015, a total of \$731,000 was paid to MBE prime and subcontractors under the DBM Statewide Audit Services Master Contract, or 42% of all dollars awarded under the contract. Because DBM has delegated this contract for MBE purposes, these awards are reported by State agencies using the contract, and are not reflected in DBM's annual report.

During FY 2015, the Department continued to work diligently on many fronts to further the goals of the State's MBE program. Within DBM we continued to:

• structure Departmental procurements to maximize the potential for MBE prime and subcontract opportunities;

- manage the statewide Audit Services Master Contract to maximize MBE awards;
- engage prospective prime contractors during the procurement process both to ensure that MBE goals were understood by potential vendors and to minimize the potential for MBE related proposal deficiencies;
- strengthen and improve the Department's MBE compliance by conducting MBE-focused contract kick off meetings for every new contract award with an MBE subcontract goal, conducting real-time monthly report monitoring and prompt payment reviews; and
- hold quarterly MBE compliance reviews with follow up meetings with contractors as required, and taking decisive actions to ensure compliance.

In our oversight capacity, DBM continued to:

- work diligently with State agencies to assure that their services procurements were structured to maximize MBE opportunities;
- document MBE compliance reporting for contract renewals and modifications; and
- promote the goals of the MBE program through training and information dissemination.
