Dear President Miller and Speaker Busch:

Section 8-105 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article requires the Secretary of Budget and Management to report to the General Assembly all amendments to the Standard Pay Plan approved during the previous calendar year on or before the 15th day of the next regular legislative session. During calendar year 2014, eleven new classifications were added to the Standard Salary Plan as follows:

- Maryland State Police/Natural Resources Police Effective July 1, 2014, the following five new
 classifications were established in the State/Natural Resources Police Salary Schedule pursuant to
 authority provided in the State Law Enforcement Officers Labor Alliance (SLEOLA) memorandum
 of understanding covering the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015:
 - o MSP Master Trooper, salary range \$49,112 \$88,483
 - o MSP Master Trooper Aviation, salary range \$54,612 \$93,983
 - o MSP Master Trooper Aviation Trauma Tech, salary range \$50,612 \$89,983
 - o MSP Master Trooper Aviation Rescue Tech, salary range \$51,612 \$90,983
 - Natural Resources Police Master Officer, salary range \$49,112 \$88,483
- Maryland State Police Effective July 1, 2014, the following six new skilled service classifications were established in accordance with the authority provided in HB 1515 Transportation Infrastructure Act of 2013:
 - o MSP Pilot I, salary range \$62,500 \$82,474
 - o MSP Pilot II, salary range \$70,000 \$92,370
 - MSP Pilot III, salary range \$74,200 \$97,912
 - o MSP Pilot IV, salary range \$78,652 \$103,788
 - o MSP Instructor Pilot, salary range \$83,371 \$110,012
 - o MSP Chief Pilot, salary range \$88,373 \$116,613
