RE: Public Utilities Article § 7-512.1(d)(2) (MSAR # 13291) – Low-Income Weatherization Component of the Electric Universal Service Program (EUSP)

President Ferguson and Speaker Jones,

Pursuant to State Government Article §7–512.1(d)(2), the Department of Housing and Community Development shall report to the General Assembly on the Low-Income Weatherization Component of the Electric Universal Service Program.

In November of 2024, the Department of Housing and Community Development received funding from the Low-Income Weatherization Component of the Electric Universal Service Program (EUSP) for the first time. The funding was received as a subaward from the Department of Human Services for the purpose of performing crisis heating and cooling projects under the Maryland Energy Assistance Program (MEAP). There is no activity on which to report as the Department is expending the LIHEAP allocated funding for the MEAP program first, before using the EUSP allocation for the program.

DHCD is anticipating that there will be EUSP activity to report on January 1, 2026.
