Mr. President and Madam Speaker,

Pursuant to the Public Utilities Article §7–512.1(d)(1), the Department of Housing and Community Development shall report to the General Assembly on the Low-Income Weatherization Component of the Electric Universal Service Program.

In November of 2025, the Department of Housing and Community Development received funding from the Low-Income Weatherization Component of the Electric Universal Service Program (EUSP). The funding was received as a subaward from the Department of Human Services for the purpose of performing crisis heating and cooling projects under the Maryland Energy Assistance Program (MEAP). This correspondence provides the recent MEAP funding activity report.
