### ANNUAL REPORT OF THE MARYLAND BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS AND THERAPISTS

2006

The Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists functions under Health Occupations Article, Title 17, Annotated Code of Maryland. The State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists (the "Board") is the licensing and certifying authority of professional counselors; marriage and family therapists and alcohol and drug counselors in the State of Maryland. The Board is mandated to regulate the practice of professional counseling and therapy in Maryland by licensing and certifying qualified counselors and therapists, promulgating regulations for the practice of professional counseling and therapy, verifying credentials, issuing licenses and certificates, establishing requirements for and verifying completion of continuing education hours, investigating complaints based on alleged violations of regulations and statutes, formal and informal disciplining of licensees and certificate holders, creating committees as deemed appropriate to advise the Board, and submitting an annual report to the Governor and Secretary.

This report covers the activity of the Maryland State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists for the period ending December 31, 2006.

### **MEETING**

During the year, the Board held 8 formal meetings, 4 administrative hearings and several ad hoc committee meetings.

#### **COMPLAINTS**

The Board received 40 complaints from the public concerning problems with the Board's licensees, which resulted in 8 referrals to the Office of Attorney General for prosecution, 4 Letters of Advisory 2 Letters of Education, 1 withdrawal by complainant, 1 referral to the Office of Health Care Quality; 1 Cease and Desist; 3 referrals to Rehabilitation Program and 20 dismissals.
