## ANNUAL REPORT OF THE MARYLAND BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS AND THERAPISTS

2007

The Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists functions under Health Occupations Article, Title 17, Annotated Code of Maryland. The State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists (the "Board") is the licensing and certifying authority of professional counselors; marriage and family therapists and alcohol and drug counselors in the State of Maryland. The Board is mandated to regulate the practice of professional counseling and therapy in Maryland by licensing and certifying qualified counselors and therapists, promulgating regulations for the practice of professional counseling and therapy, verifying credentials, issuing licenses and certificates, establishing requirements for and verifying completion of continuing education hours, investigating complaints based on alleged violations of regulations and statutes, formal and informal disciplining of licensees and certificate holders, creating committees as deemed appropriate to advise the Board, and submitting an annual report to the Governor and Secretary.

This report covers the activity of the Maryland State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists for the period ending December 31, 2007.

## **MEETING**

During the year, the Board held 6 formal meetings and 5 formal hearings. There were monthly committee meetings consisting of Ethics, Credentials and Regulations/Legislation.

#### SUNSET REVIEW

The Department of Legislative Services (DLS) completed its evaluation of the Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists in 2007 and recommended to extend the Board's termination date by 10 years to July 1, 2019. Additionally, an interim report to the Committees is due by October 1, 2010.

## **FINANCES**

The Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists is 100% special funded. Revenues are exclusively generated by the licensing and certification fees. No other State money may be used to support the operations of the Board.

The Board generated \$600,329 in revenues on 2007. Expenses totaled \$407,876.

#### 2007 LICENSE RENEWAL PROCESS

The Board offered licensees the opportunity for the on-line renewal to certificate holders and licensees with an expiration date of December 31, 2007. All licensee and certificate holders were encouraged to renew on-line as it expedites the process and allows for a credit card payment.
