I herewith transmit on behalf of the Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation and the Maryland Home Improvement Commission, the report required pursuant to Maryland Annotated Code, Business Regulation Article §8-204(c). I respectfully submit this report of the Maryland Home Improvement Commission for fiscal year 2017. This mandate requires the commission to report attendance records of each commission meeting (disaggregated by constituency represented), Guaranty Fund claims closed at each meeting, and how many claims remain open at the conclusion of each meeting.
