Dear Chairman Kasemeyer and Chairman Conway:

Section 8-206 of the Public Safety Article, Annotated Code of Maryland requires the Maryland Military Department (DMIL) to review the annual documentation submitted by the Maryland State Firemen's Association (MSFA). The purpose of this review is to determine if each grant or loan was spent in accordance with both the Volunteer Company Assistance Fund (VCAF) statute and the request approved by the Board of Public Works (BPW).

In addition Section 8-206 requires DMIL to report its findings to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee on an annual basis. This letter serves as a report on the status of FY2013 grants and loans.

In FY 2013, DMIL settled eight loans and one grant, totaling \$3,213,703.25 from the VCAF fund. The attached schedule reports the status of the required documentation that DMIL received.

DMIL continues to work with the MSFA to improve the VCAF loan process to ensure that adequate controls are in place as we jointly support the State's volunteer fire, rescue and ambulance community.
