Introduction

The Forest Conservation Act (NRA 5-1613) requires that on or before September 30 of each year, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR or Department) submit a report that shall include:

- (1) the number, location, and type of projects subject to the provisions of the Forest Conservation Act;*
- (2) the amount and location of areas cleared, conserved and planted in connection with a development project;*
- (3) the amount of reforestation and afforestation fees and noncompliance penalties collected and expended; and,*
- (4) the costs of implementing the forest conservation program;*
- (5) the size, location, and protection of any local forest mitigation banks which are created under a local or State program;*
- (6) the number, location, and type of violations and type of enforcement activity conducted in accordance with this subtitle; and*
- (7) To the extent practicable, the size and location of all conserved and planted forest areas, submitted in an electronic geographic information system or computer aided design format. (Nat. Res. Art. 5-1613, Annotated Code of Maryland)*

Amendments to the Forest Conservation Act in 1994 assigned the Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR) responsibility for collecting annual forest conservation reports from local jurisdictions and compiling a statewide report. This report summarizes project reviews by both local jurisdictions and the DNR Forest Service's State Forest Conservation Program, along with other implementation activities.

These activities may include biennial reviews of local programs, professional training, and oversight of qualified professional certifications. Since a 1998 amendment, local jurisdiction reports must include data from the previous fiscal year.

The DNR Forest Service reviews forest conservation plans for:

1. State agency projects;
2. State-funded local projects;
3. Projects in jurisdictions without an approved local program;
4. Applications submitted to jurisdictions lacking an approved program (COMAR 08.19.04.01).

Reviews are conducted by staff in four regional offices, with support from the Annapolis headquarters. The Forest Service reports on the current fiscal year's activities.

Only projects with final Forest Conservation Plan approval are reported. As each project requires review of both a Forest Stand Delineation and a Forest Conservation Plan—often approved in different years—this results in underreporting of total review activity.

Overall Summary

The combined local jurisdictions and Maryland Department of Natural Resource Forest Service reports indicate the following:

- Annual reports were submitted by:
 - **20 counties, 21 municipalities, and 1 independent city.**
 - Some municipal reports were included within their county's submission (Appendix 1).
 - **Missing reports:** Kent County, Aberdeen, Bel Air, Cambridge, Centerville, Chestertown, Church Hill, Federalsburg, Elkton, Greensboro, Hagerstown, La Plata, Laytonsville, Leonardtown, Ocean City, Oxford, and Rising Sun.
- **2,347** development activities were reviewed under Forest Conservation regulations.
- **6,931.7 acres** of existing forest were assessed across **13,116.1 acres** of net tract area.
- **3,109.5 acres** of forest were approved for clearing.
- **434.1 acres** of new forest were planted.
- **4,172.3 acres** of existing forest were retained.
- **4,606.4 acres** (both retained and planted) were placed under long-term protective agreements.

Local Jurisdictions

- **2,315** development activities were reviewed for compliance with Forest Conservation regulations.
- **6,775.6 acres** of existing forest were assessed across **12,876.2 acres** of net tract area.
- **3,089.9 acres** of forest were approved for clearing.
- **4,301.0 acres** of forest were newly planted.
- **3,359.8 acres** of existing forest were retained.
- **3,790.8 acres** were placed under long-term protective agreements.
- Since **October 1, 2019**, a total of **\$4,152,027.97** in forest mitigation fees (fees-in-lieu) has been collected, with **\$3,720,136.28** expended to date.

- **2** development activities were reviewed for Forest Conservation compliance; **17** of these qualified as exemptions.
- **156.2 acres** of existing forest were reviewed across **239.8 acres** of net tract area.
- **19.6 acres** of forest were approved for clearing.
- **3.1 acres** of new forest were planted.
- **158.6 acres** were placed under long-term protective agreements.
- **1** enforcement action was taken; **no penalties** were assessed and **no fines** were collected.

The status of the 57 jurisdictions with planning and zoning authority in the state is noted in Appendix 1.

Biennial Reviews of Local Forest Conservation Programs

The Forest Conservation Act requires the Department to conduct reviews of local forest conservation programs every two years. During these reviews, staff evaluates each local program's compliance with the intent and standards of the Act and recommends any necessary improvements. With the most recent reviews completed in FY24, the next biennial review will take place in FY26.

To the extent practicable, the size and location of all conserved and planted forest areas are submitted in an electronic Geographic Information System (GIS) or computer-aided design (CAD) format.

Since 2009, the Maryland Forest Service has collected forest conservation easement data in an electronic design format. The jurisdictions listed below submitted this data during the reporting period; it is available upon request.

Assisting Developers, Planners, Consultants and Others in Preparing Forest Stand Delineations and Forest Conservation Plans

The Forest Service continues to provide guidance and training to individuals qualified to prepare Forest Stand Delineations (FSDs) and Forest Conservation Plans (FCPs). Since 1994, the Forest Service has offered a 40-hour *Forest Conservation for Qualified Professionals* course through community colleges across the state. This course is typically offered twice a year by Carroll Community College and Anne Arundel Community College, contingent on meeting minimum enrollment requirements.

To date, approximately 887 individuals have been approved by the Department as *Qualified Professionals* under COMAR 08.19.06.01, authorizing them to prepare FSDs and FCPs. This number is in addition to Maryland Licensed Landscape Architects and Licensed Foresters, who are also authorized to prepare these plans under the Natural Resources Article §§ 5-1604 and 5-1605, Annotated Code of Maryland. Department staff assisted with numerous continuing education seminars, classroom presentations in higher education natural resources departments, at professional and local government meetings, etc.
