LEGISLATIVE REPORT - Pursuant to the language set forth in HB 1172, Chapter 520 of 2018 (MSAR# 11681) (Oyster Poaching – Administrative Penalties).

BACKGROUND

Chapter 520 of 2018 modifies the department's authority to revoke commercial oyster authorizations pursuant to certain violations of the Natural Resources Article.

Under Natural Resources Article, §4-1210, Annotated Code of Maryland, the department may initiate an action to revoke a commercial oyster authorization of a commercially licensed individual if they receive a citation for 1) taking oysters located more than 200 feet within a closed or prohibited area, 2) taking oysters with gear that is prohibited in that area, 3) taking oysters outside of a time restriction for the harvest of oysters by more than 1 hour, 4) taking oysters during closed seasons, or 5) taking oysters from a leased area by a person other than the leaseholder or the leaseholder's designee. If the presiding officer of the hearing finds that the offense was committed knowingly, the department shall revoke the individual's authorization to catch oysters.

HB 1172 required that the department submit to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Environment and Transportation Committee a report on the number of citations issued during the previous year for the enumerated offenses and the action taken. The report also outlines the penalty imposed by the department for each offense.
