Dear Chairmen Kasemeyer and Conway:

In accordance with Section 5-903 of the Natural Resources Article, the Department of Natural Resources hereby submits (attached) the annual summary of activities of the Program Open Space Contingency Fund (Fund). The Fund, which was established in 1998, may be used with the approval of the Committees and the Board of Public Works to supplement an existing appropriation for a capital project or undertake Critical Maintenance projects. Use of the fund and maintaining a sufficient balance within the fund has allowed us to move forward on a number of important improvement projects on State lands such as the bridge replacement at the Fair Hill Natural Resource Management Area after its loss during Hurricane Floyd flooding, critical maintenance of the Greenwell Manor, and lead abatement at Seneca Creek State Park. Without the benefit of the contingency fund, these and other completed projects would have been canceled or other projects would have been deferred.
