Please find enclosed the Annual Speed Monitoring Systems (SMS) Report as required by Transportation Article §21-809 (k) (1) (ii). The Report includes a summary of the various required data collected by each jurisdiction for FY-2019. Forty-one (41) local jurisdictions with speed monitoring systems reported the data to the Police Training and Standards Commission as required by law.

Because of the volume of data that TR §21-809 (k) (2) requires each jurisdiction to report, particularly:

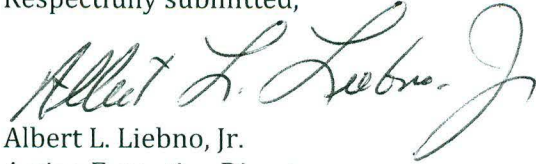
- (x) locations at which each speed monitoring system was used in the local jurisdiction;
- (xi) activation start and stop dates of each speed monitoring system for each location at which it was used; and
- (xii) number of citations issued by each speed monitoring system at each location.

It was decided that a compact disc along with this written summary report was the most practical and efficient way to submit the required information to the Legislature. The written Report summarizes each jurisdiction's SMS experience in this fiscal year, and the compact disc contains each jurisdiction's complete report including the data listed above.

Pursuant to TR §21-809 (k)(1)(i), the Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commissions will make the report available to the public by posting it on its website, www.mdle.net by the 31st of December. This report is being submitted to the Legislature in accordance with State Government Article § 2-1257.

2019 REPORT TO THE STATE OF MARYLAND – SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS USE

Fiscal Year 2019 (July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019)

Introduction

On October 1, 2014, the *Speed Monitoring Systems [SMS] Reform Act of 2014* was enacted and became effective. This law, which can be found in detail in Transportation §21-809, requires local law enforcement agencies or local jurisdictions that operate/administer, as permitted by law, a speed monitoring program [colloquially referred to as “speed cameras”] to report certain specific information regarding their program to the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission. Information from the previous fiscal year is required to be reported by October 31st of each year. The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission is required to provide the General Assembly with a report of the information provided by the local law enforcement agencies and local jurisdictions by December 31st of each calendar year.

Methodology of Collection and Submission of Information

The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission developed a basic reporting document in 2014. The reporting document was updated for FY18. Every local jurisdiction operating a speed monitoring system was provided the updated document to self-report the law eligible information to the Commission. TR §21-809(k)(2) requires each jurisdiction to self-report the following information to the Commission:

- i. total number of citations issued;
- ii. number of citations issued, and the number voided as erroneous violations for each camera;
- iii. gross revenue generated by the program;
- iv. expenditures incurred by the program;
- v. net revenue generated by the program;
- vi. total amount of any payments made to a contractor under the program;
- vii. a description of how the net revenue generated by the program was used;
- viii. number of employees of the local jurisdiction involved in the program;
- ix. type of speed monitoring system used by the local jurisdiction;
- x. locations at which each speed monitoring system for each location at which it was used; and
- xi. number of citations issued by each speed monitoring system at each location.

Reporting Jurisdictions

In FY17, there were a total of 37 jurisdictions reporting the operation of speed monitoring systems. A notification was sent to all Maryland police agencies that had reported in FY18 from the staff of the Police and Correctional Training Commissions reminding them of the requirements of Transportation §21-809. The template from FY2018 was provided with the notification. A separate email notification was sent to all chiefs and sheriffs advising of the requirement in the event a jurisdiction had added a speed monitoring system. A total of 41 agencies were identified as operating speed monitoring systems in FY19.
