Dear Governor Hogan:

In accordance with MSAR 12077, Maryland State Transportation Article §21-809 (k) requires the Police Training and Standards Commission (PTSC) to collect information on local law enforcement agencies' utilization of speed monitoring systems (SMS) and submit this information in accordance with State Government Article § 2-1246 on an annual basis. Specifically, Sections 21 - 809 (k) (2)(x)-(xii) of the Maryland Transportation Article require each jurisdiction that utilizes a SMS to report to the PTSC:

“(x) locations at which each speed monitoring system was used in the local jurisdiction;

(xi) activation start and stop dates of each speed monitoring system for each location at which it was used; and

(xii) number of citations issued by each speed monitoring system at each location.”

Due to the volume of data collected from the forty-one (41) local jurisdictions, the PTSC is submitting both a written summary as well as a compact disc containing datasets for each jurisdiction (see attached). This information will also be made available to the public as it will be posted on the Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commissions' website at: [www.mdle.net](http://www.mdle.net).

## 2020 REPORT TO THE STATE OF MARYLAND – SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS USE

Fiscal Year 2020 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020)

### Introduction

On October 1, 2014, the *Speed Monitoring Systems [SMS] Reform Act of 2014* was enacted and became effective. This law, which can be found in detail in Transportation Article §21-809, requires local law enforcement agencies or local jurisdictions that operate/administer, as permitted by law, a speed monitoring program [colloquially referred to as “speed cameras”] to report certain specific information regarding their program to the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission. Information from the previous fiscal year is required to be reported by October 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission is required to provide the General Assembly with a report of the information provided by the local law enforcement agencies and local jurisdictions by December 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year.

### Methodology of Collection and Submission of Information

The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission developed a basic reporting document in 2014. The reporting document was updated beginning with FY18 reporting. The agency head and, as applicable, the individual who submitted the report for the prior year for every local jurisdiction received an email reminder in September 2020. Agencies that had submitted data for the previous year also received a template for the current year. Agency heads for all other law enforcement jurisdictions in Maryland received an email advising them of the reporting requirement in the event their agency had implemented SMS during the calendar year. An agency that indicated adding SMS in their jurisdiction during the report period for FY20 was provided with a template.

Transportation Article §21-809(k)(2) requires each jurisdiction to self-report the following information to the Commission:

- i. total number of citations issued;
- ii. number of citations issued, and the number voided as erroneous violations for each camera;
- iii. gross revenue generated by the program;
- iv. expenditures incurred by the program;
- v. net revenue generated by the program;
- vi. total amount of any payments made to a contractor under the program;
- vii. a description of how the net revenue generated by the program was used;
- viii. number of employees of the local jurisdiction involved in the program;
- ix. type of speed monitoring system used by the local jurisdiction;
- x. locations at which each speed monitoring system for each location at which it was used;
- xi. the activation start and stop dates of each speed monitoring system for each location at which it was used; and
- xii. number of citations issued by each speed monitoring system at each location.

## Reporting Jurisdictions

A total of 41 agencies were identified as operating speed monitoring systems in FY20. Data for the 41 reporting agencies is provided below.
