# **FISCAL YEAR 2025 REPORT TO THE STATE OF MARYLAND SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS**

Fiscal Year 2025 (July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025)

## **Introduction**

Pursuant to Transportation Article 21-809(k) (SB580/Ch. 8, 2019) the Police Training and Standards Commission respectfully submits this report on Speed Monitoring Systems (SMS). This law requires the following information from local jurisdictions operating a Speed Monitoring Program under this section:

- (1) On or before December 31 of each year, the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission shall:
  - (i) compile and make publicly available a report for the previous fiscal year on each speed monitoring system program operated by a local jurisdiction under this section; and
  - (ii) submit the report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- (2) The report shall include:
  - (i) the total number of citations issued;
  - (ii) the number of citations issued and the number voided as erroneous violations for each camera;
  - (iii) the gross revenue generated by the program;
  - (iv) the expenditures incurred by the program;
  - (v) the net revenue generated by the program;
  - (vi) the total amount of any payments made to a contractor under the program;
  - (vii) a description of how the net revenue generated by the program was used;
  - (viii) the number of employees of the local jurisdiction involved in the program;
  - (ix) the type of speed monitoring system used by the local jurisdiction;
  - (x) the locations at which each speed monitoring system was used in the local jurisdiction;
  - (xi) the activation start and stop dates of each speed monitoring system for each location at which it was used; and
  - (xii) the number of citations issued by each speed monitoring system at each location.

## **Methodology of Collection and Submission of Information**

The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission developed a basic reporting document in 2014. The reporting document was updated beginning with FY18 reporting. The agency head and, as applicable, the individual who submitted the report for the prior year for every local jurisdiction received an email reminder in July 2025. Agencies that had submitted data for the previous year also received a template for the current year. Agency heads for all other law enforcement jurisdictions in Maryland received an email advising them of the reporting requirement in the event their agency had implemented SMS during FY 25. An agency that indicated adding SMS in their jurisdiction during the report period for FY25 was provided with a template.

## **Reporting Jurisdictions**

A total of 57 agencies were identified as operating speed-monitoring systems in FY25, compared to 53 jurisdictions reporting in FY24. The newest jurisdictions to the Speed Monitoring Program for FY25 were identified as the Brentwood Police Department, Colmar Manor Police Department, La Plata Police Department, and the Town of Church Hill.

One agency did not file a report for FY 2025, Cottage City Police Department. Also, the Montgomery County Police Department was unable to provide data due to an on-going contractual dispute. Data for the 55 reporting agencies is included in this report.
