Dear Governor Moore, President Ferguson, and Speaker Jones:

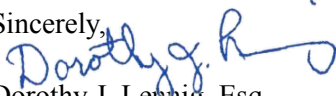
In accordance with § 8-1309(a)(2) of the Human Services Article, which requires the Commission on Trauma-Informed Care (Commission) to submit a report on its findings and recommendations by June 30 of each year, please accept this letter as notification that a report is forthcoming.

Sections 8-1302, 8-1305, and 8-1307 of the Human Services Article established the Commission as an independent entity within the Department of Human Services (DHS) and required the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention and Policy (GOCPP) to staff and chair the Commission. Section 8-1309(a)(2) of this article also required the Commission to submit a report to the Governor and General Assembly by June 30 each year.

Due to the recent transfer of the Commission's staffing and reporting to DHS, pursuant to Executive Order 01.01.2024.06, the Commission requires additional time to gather information from members and produce a report with meaningful findings and recommendations. Therefore, DHS will submit a report later this year.
