Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Career and Technical Education (CTE) Committee, defined in Md. Ann. Code, Ed. Art. §21-209, is submitting the following letter to inform the Governor and, in accordance with §2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly, and the Accountability and Implementation Board (AIB) that the CTE Committee was unable to provide the 2023 report required by Education Article § 21-204(b) (MSAR # 13174). The report, which is due annually on or before December 1, is required to detail the progress, by high school, toward attaining the goals established by the CTE Committee. In 2023, the CTE Committee was still defining these goals and did not have access to the data required to submit this report. Furthermore, this statutorily required report was updated pursuant to House Bill 1426, Chapter 164 of the 2024 Maryland General Assembly legislative session, to change the first iteration of this report as being due “on or before December 1 each year, beginning in 2024.”
