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**Maryland Board of Physicians  
Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Annual Reporting Requirements**

Pursuant to the Health Occupations Article (H.O.), Md. Code Annotated, §14-205.1 and Chapters 612 and 613, Acts of 2020, information regarding the operations of the Maryland Board of Physicians (the “Board”) as outlined in items 1 through 18 below is provided as follows:

**1. The number of new complaints<sup>1</sup> investigated for physicians, allied health practitioners, and unlicensed individuals:**

- 1,018 complaints

**3. The three most common grounds for complaints:**

- Disciplinary Ground §14-404(a)(3)(ii), is guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine;
  - 263 allegations of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.
- Disciplinary Ground §14-404(a)(22), fails to meet appropriate standards as determined by appropriate peer review of the delivery of quality medical and surgical care performed in an outpatient surgical facility, office, hospital, or any other location in this State;
  - 300 allegations of failure to meet the standard of care.
- Disciplinary Ground §14-404(a)(40), fails to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review;
  - 40 allegations of failure to keep adequate medical records.

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<sup>1</sup> All complaints received by the Board do not result in an investigation (for example, complaints against other providers licensed by other boards, complaints against facilities, or those where the Board lacks jurisdiction).
