Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Career and Technical Education (CTE) Committee, defined in Md. Code ED § 21-209, is submitting the following letter to inform the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly, and the Accountability and Implementation Board (AIB) that the CTE Committee is unable to provide the 2022 report required by Education Article § 21-204(b) (MSAR # 13174). The report, which is due annually on or before December 1 starting in 2022, is required to detail the progress, by high school, toward attaining the goals established by the CTE Committee.

The CTE Committee was not fully appointed and established until August 2022, and does not yet have access to the data required for this report. Over 2023, the CTE Committee will work with the AIB and other entities to establish a system for collecting and reporting the data necessary for this report.
