Dear President Miller and Speaker Busch:

In accordance with Section 6-204(p) of the Transportation Article (Chapter 205, 1998 Laws of Maryland), I am submitting this report as Chairman of the Maryland Port Commission on actions taken under this subsection during fiscal year 2009. Through this Article, the Maryland Port Commission is authorized to appoint up to a total of twelve management personnel to perform services for Maryland International Terminals, Inc. (MIT), the Maryland Port Administration's (MPA's) private operating company. The Commission was also granted the authority to determine the qualifications, appointments, and/or compensation needs for these employees. The statute directs:

*"On or before December 1 of each year, the Commission shall report to the Governor and the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly on actions taken by the Commission under this subsection during the previous fiscal year with regard to individuals subject to the subsection."*

During fiscal year 2010, the Port Commission took one action related to MIT employees, as follows:

- Approved the appointment of Joseph M. Greco as Deputy Director of Marketing at an annual salary of \$105,057 (PIN 889308).
