MSAR #7366 December 2022 The Maryland Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Administration (MDOT MVA) prepared this report in response to language contained in the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article, § 6-313(h), Annotated Code of Maryland. The language states:

"The Motor Vehicle Administration shall report to the General Assembly on or before January 1 of each year, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the following information for the preceding calendar year:

- 1. The total number of subpoenas, summonses, and other service of process issued in accordance with the provisions of this section;
- 2. The number of instances in which the Motor Vehicle Administration failed to reach the individual being served and the reasons that those attempts failed;
- 3. A breakdown of all direct and indirect costs incurred by the Motor Vehicle Administration in carrying out the requirements of this section; and
- 4. The total fees collected by the Motor Vehicle Administration from persons requesting service of process under this section."

This statute designates the MDOT MVA as the agent for a nonresident driver with regard to service of process related to a crash involving a motor vehicle driven by the nonresident. The language also allows the MDOT MVA to establish and collect a fee to recover MDOT MVA's costs. The provisions apply prospectively to cases filed on or after October 1, 2008.

The MDOT MVA reports the following totals for calendar year October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022:

•	Total fees collected (478 x \$61)\$ 33,123

The MDOT MVA experienced a significant increase in requests for service of process in 2022. Requests have now surpassed pre-COVID 19 pandemic levels, and the MDOT MVA again anticipates a moderate progressive increase in the volume of subpoenas issued and revenue collected going forward. As demonstrated below, this program has already increased considerably and, as more attorneys become aware of the availability of this service, that trend is expected to continue.
