RE: Report required by Public Safety Article §2-315 and §2-316 (MSAR# 12978, 12982)

In accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the Maryland Department of State Police submits to you the report on the Law Enforcement Coordinating Council (LECC) and Regional Law Enforcement Councils RLEC).

As required in the law, the LECC convened two meetings in 2021. The first meeting was held on May 24, 2021. The second meeting was held on October 26, 2021. Intelligence related to criminal activity and deployment of police resources were briefed by participating agencies. Minutes from both meetings are attached to this report. No legislative recommendations were forwarded to the Chair during either meeting. Following discussion with the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention, Youth and Victim Services (GOCPYVS), the LECC has been included as part of the GOCPYVS Maryland Comprehensive State Crime Control and Prevention Plan.


An additional requirement in the statute was the establishment of Regional Law Enforcement Councils (RLEC). After consultation with the Maryland Chiefs of Police and Maryland Sheriffs' Associations, four regions were established. They are:

**Baltimore Metropolitan Region** - consisting of Annapolis, Anne Arundel County, Baltimore, Baltimore County, Carroll County, Cecil County, Harford County, Howard County, Montgomery County, Prince George's County.

*Eastern Shore Region* - *consisting of C*aroline County, Dorchester County, Kent County, Ocean City, Queen Anne's County, Somerset County, Talbot County, Wicomico County, Worcester County.

Southern Maryland Region - consisting of Calvert County, Charles County, Saint Mary's County.

*Western Maryland Region - consisting of* Allegany County, Frederick County, Garrett County, Washington County.
