RE: Maryland Senate Bill 907 - Law Enforcement Coordinating Council Annual Report

In accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the Maryland Department of State Police submits to you the report on the Law Enforcement Coordinating Council (LECC) and Regional Law Enforcement Councils RLEC).

As required in the Bill, the LECC convened two meetings in 2022. The first meeting was held on May 25, 2022. The second meeting was held on November 7, 2022. Intelligence related to criminal activity and deployment of police resources were briefed by participating agencies. Minutes from both meetings are attached to this report. No legislative recommendations were forwarded to the Chair during either meeting.


An additional requirement was the establishment of Regional Law Enforcement Councils (RLEC). They are:

Baltimore Metropolitan Region - consisting of Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Cecil, Harford, Howard, Montgomery, Prince George's Counties, Annapolis and Baltimore Cities.

Eastern Shore Region - consisting of Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, Worcester Counties and Ocean City.

Southern Maryland Region - consisting of Calvert, Charles, Saint Mary's Counties.

Western Maryland Region - consisting of Allegany, Garrett, Frederick, and Washington Counties.
