### Report to the General Assembly

Status of Charlotte Hall Veterans Home – Gifts and Grants FY20

The Charlotte Hall Veterans Home – Gifts and Grants – Authority to Accept and Spend Act, 2011 Legislative Session Chapter 200, HB 332, Act took effect on October 1, 2011.

#### The Cost of Administration of the Gifts and Grants

There were no charges to Charlotte Hall Veterans Home for costs of administration in fiscal year 2020.

#### Gross Amount of Gifts and Grants Credited to Charlotte Hall Veterans Home

- **\$135,227.07** in contributions were made to Charlotte Hall Veterans Home during fiscal year 2020 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020).

#### A Detailed Accounting of the Use of the Funds

Below is an itemized report of expenditures and a few examples of how the donations were used:

- **\$18,223.78** – Resident activities such as outings, BINGO, It's Never Too Late System, food socials, TV's, Music & Memory program, and entertainment.
  - **\$39,743.89** – Resident personal care items such as outdoor recreation equipment, furniture, enhanced communication system, Broda Chairs, wheelchairs, dental and optometry needs, Final Honors.
  - **\$8,607.59** – Resident-centered miscellaneous projects such as equipment upgrades, transportation tickets arrangements, and memorial plaques.
- \$66,575.26** – total expenditures

Therefore, the unspent balance of gifts and grants received in FY 2020 is **\$68,651.81**, as of July 1, 2020.
