Status of Charlotte Hall Veterans Home – Gifts and Grants FY22

The Charlotte Hall Veterans Home – Gifts and Grants – Authority to Accept and Spend Act, 2011 Legislative Session Chapter 200, HB 332, Act took effect on October 1, 2011. This report is submitted pursuant to State Government Article 9-912.1.

The Cost of Administration of the Gifts and Grants

There were no charges to Charlotte Hall Veterans Home for costs of administration of gifts and grants received in fiscal year 2022.
