Re: Report on the Maryland Higher Education Outreach and College Access Pilot Program Report #11672

Dear President Ferguson and Speaker Jones,

As stated in §11-1106 of the Education Article:

- "(a) The Commission shall prepare a report on the Program that includes:
- (1) A summary of the reports received from the participating nonprofit organizations regarding the Program;
 - (2) The amount of funds distributed each fiscal year;
- (3) Information regarding the effectiveness of the Program, including whether students matriculate and remain continuously enrolled in higher education as a result of the Program; and
- (4) If an eligible wait list exists, the number of nonprofit organizations on the wait list.
- (b) On or before December 1 in 2017 through 2021, the Commission shall submit a copy of the report required under subsection (a) of this section to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article."

The Maryland Higher Education Outreach and College Access Pilot Program is a pilot program created in §11-1101 of the Education Article that provides "funding for nonprofit organizations that are already established in communities to provide targeted outreach to encourage low–income students to enroll in college." This program did not receive funding in FY20.
