Summary of Information Concerning Oral Health Education and Student Health, Well-Being, and Growth in Maryland's Local School Systems

June 2016

Pursuant to ED § 7-401(d) and ED § 4-111.1

HB 9/Ch. 347, 2012 SB 867/Ch. 604/HB1401/Ch. 605, 2012 (MSAR #9269 and #9168) The Department of Curriculum, Accountability and Assessment (DCAA) at the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) has taken multiple steps to support and encourage instruction on the importance of physical activity in maintaining good health. Additionally, the department has encouraged the local boards to incorporate age-appropriate lessons on dating violence and diabetes and its treatment and prevention into the curriculum of the local school system. Each year since the passage of the 2012 legislation, two briefings have been hosted by MSDE's Office of Comprehensive Health for health education coordinators in local school systems. Topics at these briefings have included physical activity and fitness, oral and dental health, dating violence and healthy relationships as well as diabetes and its prevention.

Since the 2012-13 school-year, local school system health coordinators have been briefed on appropriate legislation, including Senate Bill 9, Education - Children and Youth - Reporting of Information Concerning Student Health, Well-Being, and Growth and Senate Bill 867/House Bill 1401, State Department of Education - Oral Health Education. MSDE DCAA staff reviewed roles and responsibilities in fulfilling the requirements of the bills: (1) The inclusion of instruction in health education of the importance of physical activity in maintaining good health; (2) the reporting on the incorporation of age-appropriate lessons on dating violence; (3) the reporting on the inclusion of curriculum about diabetes and its treatment and prevention; (4) support and facilitate oral health education; (5) develop a process to monitor the implementation; and (6) submit a summary of the information reported during the certification of the Health Education State Curriculum. Further, in 2015, MSDE invited Dr. Winifred Booker of the Children's Oral Health Institute (COHI) to present on the need for increased oral health education to local supervisors; Dr. Booker provided online resources and information on supplies for school students across the state.

As a part of ongoing communication and encouragement, the Office of Comprehensive Health Education has spotlighted resources that are available for local education agencies through, guest speakers, online newsletters, other email communications as well as personal visits with each local supervisor. Communication with local districts and partner will continue into the future.

During the 2015 certification of the COMAR 13A.04.18, Comprehensive Health Education

Instructional Programs for Grades Pre-kindergarten – 12, twenty four local school systems certified

that their curriculum included oral health education and diabetes and its treatment and prevention. In addition all twenty four local school systems certified that they met the content standard of personal health in addition to family life and human sexuality that include indicators regarding the importance of physical fitness and age appropriate instruction on dating violence. During the 2020 Certification of COMAR 13A.04.18 this report will be combined with the two reports on the summary of oral health education in Maryland school systems. Individual responses from school systems are included with this report.
