## Components:

- 1 Partnerships exists between education programs at the State and local levels and community suicide prevention and crisis center agencies.
- 2 Individual, family, and group counseling related to youth suicide prevention are offered to students.
- 3 Referral services, interventions, and information for students, parents, and school personnel related to youth suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention are provided.
- 4 Training is provided for school personnel and others responsible for counseling or supervising student activities.
- 5 Specified components are included in various school programs.
- 6 Youth suicide prevention programs are considered effective.
- 7 Various measurements are in place to determine the effectiveness of the suicide prevention program.
- 8 Results are available on the measurement of youth suicide prevention programs.
