Dear Chairmen Griffith and Barnes:

Chapter 188 of the Acts of 2016 requires the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System to submit an annual report to the Joint Committee on Pensions that provides the number of individuals who resumed employment with a participating employer of the State Retirement and Pension System in the previous fiscal year in a position that required membership in the Employees' Pension System (EPS) or Teachers' Pension System (TPS) and who was also re-enrolled in the Alternate Contributory Pension Selection tier of either the EPS or TPS at the time they resumed employment.

This information is provided for Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019 as follows:
