Re: Judges' Retirement System - Re-employment Report

Dear Chairpersons:


Effective July 1, 2010, House Bill 635 (Chapter 688) requires the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals to submit an annual report on or before September 1 to the Committee that provides:

1. The number of rehired judge retirees under Section 27-406 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article;
2. The employer rehiring a retiree;
3. The annual salary of each rehired retiree at the time of retirement; and
4. The current annual salary of each rehired retiree.

Please find enclosed revised reports for 2011 and 2012 as information listed in those reports was unknown until the compilation of the 2013 report.

In compliance with the statute, the Judiciary reports that none of the judges who have retired since the beginning of the 2013 fiscal year have been rehired under the conditions of the enacted legislation.
